
Lawmakers Celebrate Dogs, Responsible Dog Ownership at Meet the Breeds in NYC

In New York City on Saturday, February 10,

dozens of legislators and legislative staff had the opportunity to meet with thousands of dog breeders, owners, and dog lovers at the annual AKC Meet the Breeds event held in conjunction with the Westminster Kennel Club.

This event, attended by more than 14,000 dog lovers give the general public the opportunity to interact with more than 150 dog breeds and to talk with top dog breeders and exhibitors to learn about the right dog for their family.

More than 120 tri-state lawmakers signed on as Honorary Chairs for this event, and many brought their families and staff to meet the dogs (and cats), interact with constituents, and publicly sign the AKC Pet Promise to declare their public support for responsible pet ownership.
