TO: JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP APPLICANTS

Enclosed is a **Junior Showmanship Application Kit** for your completion and return. The kit includes:

- Requirement Sheet: Explanation of application process
- Occupational Eligibility Addendum: Explanation of Chapter 7, Section 1 of the Rules.
- JS Application: Information on background and experience
- Current permit judges must be granted regular status on all breeds before applying for Junior Showmanship. (Applied to New Breed Judges). Adjunct breeds are exempt from this requirement.
- Booklet, it is recommended that you refer to the <u>Junior Showmanship</u> <u>Regulations/Judging Guidelines</u>: Upon receipt of a completed application, you will be enrolled into the AKC Canine College for this exam.

An application fee of <u>\$35</u> must be submitted with the application. Fees are non-refundable. <u>Checks, money orders and credit cards will be accepted</u>. Any application considered incomplete by Staff will be returned together with the processing fee.

Return the forms to Judging Operations Department and keep a copy for your files. Reminder, the application MUST be signed and dated.

In order to accept your application the following items must be returned to the office:

- ✓ Junior Showmanship Application
- Occupational Eligibility Addendum: Explanation of Chapter 7, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- ✓ Check/Money order/Credit Card

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP APPLICANT

Judging Requirements

Junior Showmanship All-Breed applicants must meet THREE of the following requirements and pass an Open Book Exam to be eligible to apply. Junior Showmanship-Limit applicants must meet TWO of the following requirements and pass an Open Book Exam to be eligible to apply:

- A previous Junior Show Handler
- Judged Junior Showmanship at least 3 times at AKC All Breed Sanctioned Matches
- Parent of a Junior
- ◆ Professional Handler
- Applicant attended a seminar on judging of Junior Showmanship in the last 24 months sponsored by the AKC Judging Operations Department.**
- Taught All-Breed Handling classes

** Attendance at a Junior Showmanship Seminar may count as two of the requirements.

Approval to judge All Breed JS requires extensive background in many breeds, and experience must be noted on the application.

Application must be submitted with Occupational Eligibility Addendum form and fee. Notification will be sent via the AKC Canine College informing the applicant they have been enrolled and may now complete the Junior Showmanship exam. Reminder, passing grade must be achieved on exam, prior to scheduling your final interview.

The approval process includes an opportunity for the fancy to respond to each application to judge. Applicants will be published twice in the Secretary's Page of the AKC GAZETTE. The applicant's name will be published in the first available issue of the AKC GAZETTE following receipt by the Department allowing the fancy to be aware of and comment on the judges' application. Upon the review of any responses received you will be advised of any questions or concerns that arise and provided the opportunity to respond before any further AKC action is taken if warranted.

Following the interview, the result of the interview with the Executive Field Representative and any comments received from the fancy will be reviewed by the Department. Judges will be informed by mail or email of the result of the Department's review. Applicants may not accept assignments until they have received official notification of their status from the Department.

After completing **five** permit assignments with three satisfactory observation reports on file, the judge may request regular status. A Staff Committee evaluates requests and the judge is advised of the Staff Committee's decision. The judge's name and class are added to AKC's Website and published in the next available issue of the Gazette.

INTERVIEW PROCESS

Your application should be sent to the office together with the processing fee. Upon receipt of complete application, you will be enrolled in the Junior Showmanship exam and directed to the AKC Canine College to complete. The final interview must be scheduled through Judging Operations. Applicants may choose to come into the North Carolina office for their interview.

SIGNING/CERTIFICATION

I certify that I am familar with the American Kennel Club's Rules, Regulations, Policies and Guidelines for Conformation Dog Show Judges and agree to abide by them. That I am occupationally eligible to judge under AKC Dog Show Rules and will adhere to the restrictions, if applicable, outlined in the Occupational Eligibility Addendum clarifying Chapter 7, Section 1.

If granted permit judging status, I fully understand that my judging eligibility is conditional and, therefore, reviewable by AKC at any time subsequent to the date the status is initially granted.

I certify that I understand and acknowledge that if I am charged with inappropriate treatment of a dog ("inappropriate treatment" means any offense involving a dog that alleges cruelty, abuse, neglect or improper treatment of a dog as defined by AKC), or charged with any crime involving moral turpitude, especially as it concerns dog-related activities. The AKC may temporarily place my judging privileges on referral and judging status as Inactive while the charges are pending. Further, after receiving notification of the referral, I am prevented from judging or from accepting assignments to judge. When the charges are resolved and AKC's inquiry into the matter determines that no action will be taken by the AKC to cause a suspension of my judging privileges, the temporary judging referral will be removed.
