Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex will be awarded in each breed.

Dogs <u>ranked in the top ten (plus ties) of their breed</u> at the end of the 2017 qualifying period (October 13, 2016 – October 11, 2017) will be invited to compete in the AKC NOHS Finals. The Finals premium list will be available in September when the overall

AKC National Championship information is published and Finals qualifiers will be sent full details about the event and notified about how to enter in early November.
